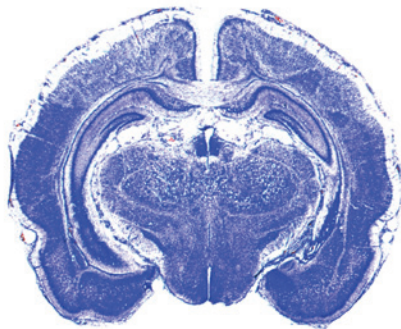

Course Objectives

This educational course summarizes the contemporary situation in the epidemiology, pathogenesis and treatment of meningitis.

Epidemiology of meningitis
