## Organization

### Summer School Venue

The course will take place in the Cappadocia Vocational College, Nevsehir, Turkey. All participants will be accommodated in the College.

### Registration Fee

Early registration (until 6 May 2010)  
ESCMID members: EUR 650  
All others: EUR 750

Late registration (from 7 May to 4 June 2010)  
ESCMID members: EUR 750  
All others: EUR 850

The fee covers the course, educational material, six nights in a double room shared with a co-student, all meals for six days and the social events, as well as the transfer from Kayseri Erkilet Airport (ASR) to the College and back. Extra cost for a single room is EUR 220.

### Attendance Grants

ESCMID members can apply for a limited number of attendance grants until 6 May 2010, covering the registration fee of EUR 650. Recipients of a grant will be notified by 28 May 2010.

### Application Procedure

To apply for the ESCMID Summer School 2010, please register via the internet at [www.escmid.org/summerschool](http://www.escmid.org/summerschool). As part of the application we request you to send a short letter explaining your professional situation and motivation for attending the Summer School and a brief CV. In addition, each participant is requested to submit a short description of an educational case/problem for presentation and discussion during the Summer School. Applications are accepted until 6 May 2010; for late application check with the administrative secretariat. Participants will be

selected by the ESCMID Education Subcommittee. Registration will be confirmed by 28 May 2010.

### Case Study Preparation

Participants are requested to submit a case or problem as part of the application for attending the ESCMID Summer School. All participants will present their cases during the course. The case should come from the professional experience of the applicant, be of practical relevance and have some educational value. The description should not exceed 2500 characters. Please check the Summer School website for detailed guidance.

### CME Accreditation

The organizers of the ESCMID Summer School will apply for European CME accreditation through EACCME.
