Founded in 1983, ESCMID now has some 3'800 full members all over the world. Combined with its associated and affiliated memberships, ESCMID reaches out to over 33'000 professionals. The Society is a non-profit organization registered in Germany, with offices in Munich and Paris and administrative headquarters in Basel. ESCMID has been an influential component in the professional lives of microbiologists and infectious diseases specialists for more than 25 years and looks forward to welcoming new colleagues.

Main activities comprise postgraduate training, continuing medical education, annual congresses, scientific conferences, study groups, working parties as well as professional and public affairs. Regular publications include: *Clinical Microbiology and Infection (CMI)*, a monthly peer-reviewed journal, and the ESCMID Newsletter.
