

Definition: S.I.M.I.T. (*Società Italiana di Malattie Infettive e Tropicali*) is the Italian Society for Infectious and Tropical Diseases, funded in 2001 by the merging of the two pre-existing Scientific Societies: A.M.I.T. (*Associazione Medici Ospedalieri Infettivologi*) and S.I.S.M.I.P. (*Società Italiana per lo Studio delle Malattie Infettive e Parassitarie*).

Mission: as defined in S.I.M.I.T. Statute:

- Studying Infectious and Tropical Diseases
- Organising Courses and Scientific activities
- Cooperating with other Medical Societies
- Publishing guidelines and official documents
- Promoting studies in Infectious Disease

Headquarters: S.I.M.I.T. headquarter is in Firenze, Via della Mattonaia, 17 – zip code 50121 (Italy); the Society is officially registered as n. 413 in the Italian Public Registry.

Official Journal: S.I.M.I.T.'s official journal is "*Infection – A Journal of Infectious Disease*", bimonthly published by Springer in Munich (Germany) and indexed in Journal Citation Reports (Thomson Reuter); 2009 Impact Factor = 1,831.

Board: S.I.M.I.T. is ruled by an elected 19 Members Advisory Board, coordinated by a President, a Vice-President (President-elect), and a Secretary (Presidency Board). General Assembly: S.I.M.I.T.'s General Assembly meets once a year, usually during the National SIMIT Conference.

Membership: S.I.M.I.T. is the reference scientific Society for the Italian medical community dealing with communicable and imported diseases in the over 100 units for Infectious and Tropical Diseases in Italy. At 31 December 2009, S.I.M.I.T. counted 937 members. Membership applications are approved during the Advisory Board meetings.
