- Outpatient clinic with a particular interest in HIV, immune deficiencies, neuroinfections, hepatitis and management of the returning travelers.

 - One of the world's leading research centers in the area of HIV latency and HIV cure.
- International Center for Immunodeficiency Diseases
 - One of Denmark's leading centers in research and clinical care of patients with immune deficiencies.
- International Center for Global Infectious Diseases
 - Long-standing involvement in Africa including running the Bissau HIV Cohort – the largest HIV-2 cohort in the world.
