

What is e-Bug?

e-Bug is a health intervention project comprised of **educational resources** and an accompanying website to enhance student knowledge on four key areas:



- Introduction to microbes
- Spread of infection
- Treatment of infection
- Prevention of infection



Aim

All children will leave school with a knowledge of **prudent antibiotic use** and how to reduce the spread of infections for themselves and future young children, which is where much of the antibiotic misuse occurs.

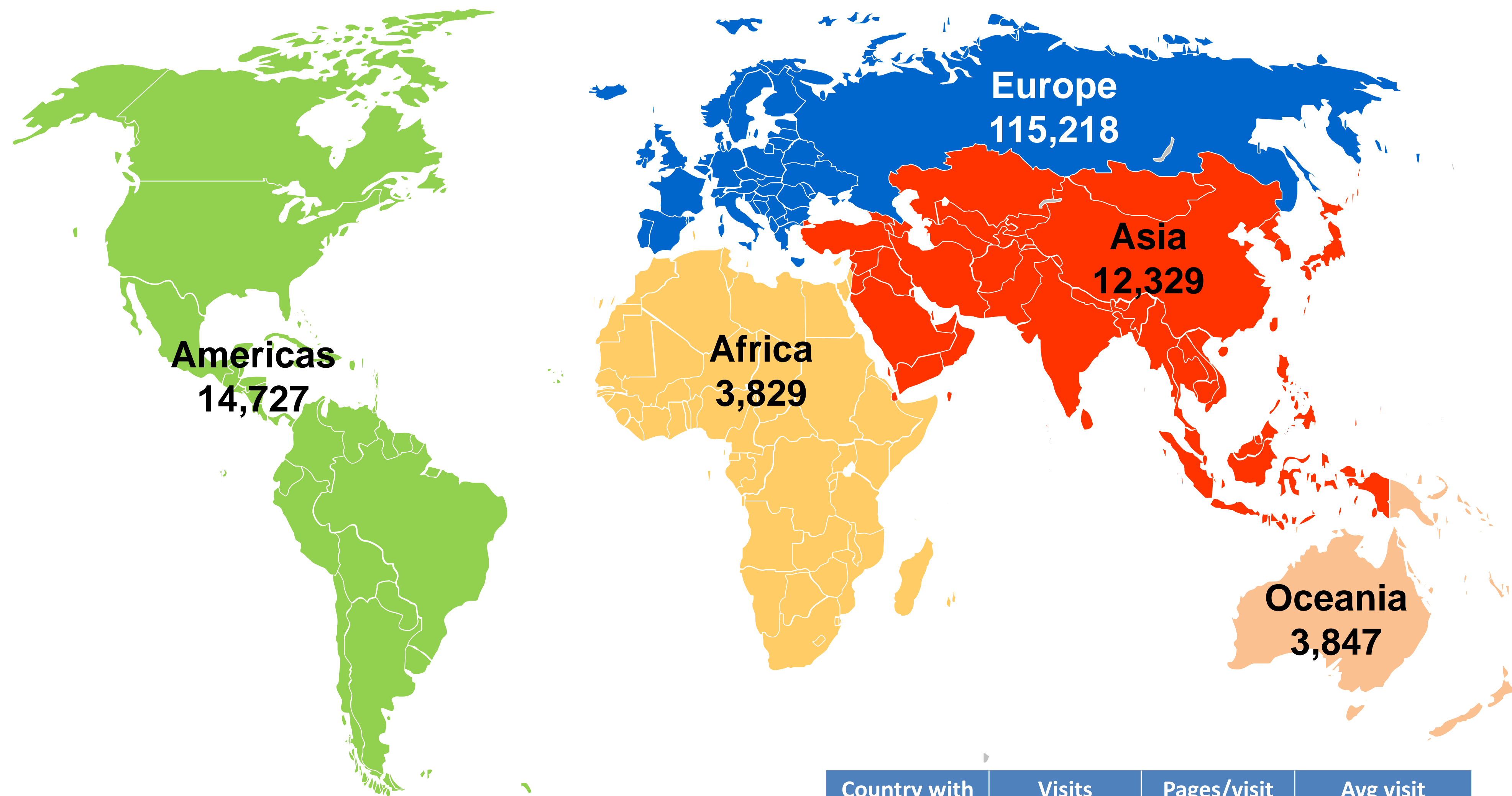

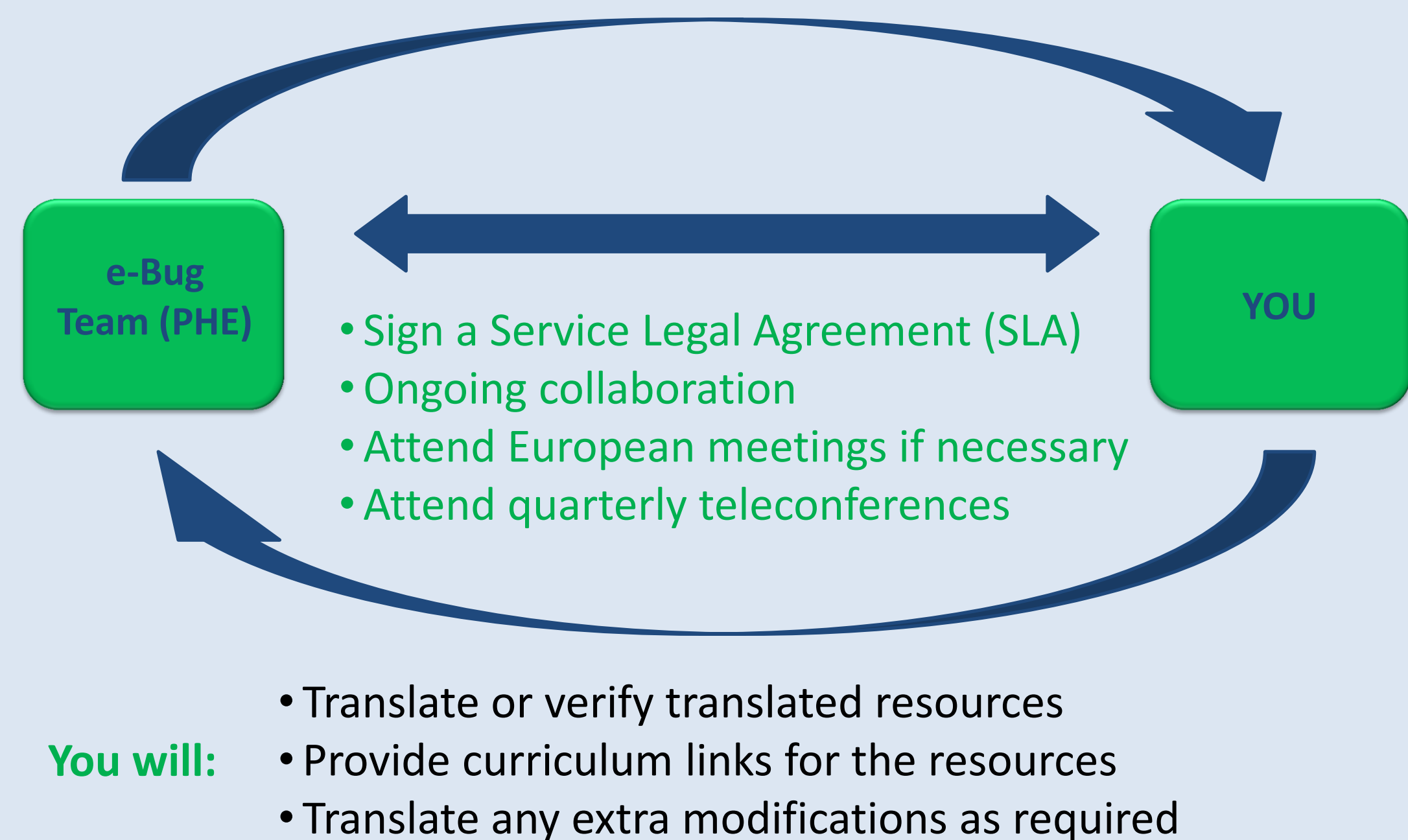
