Hospitalization ward

- 27 beds for acute patients, including:
- 3 beds with negative pressure
- 8 beds for isolation

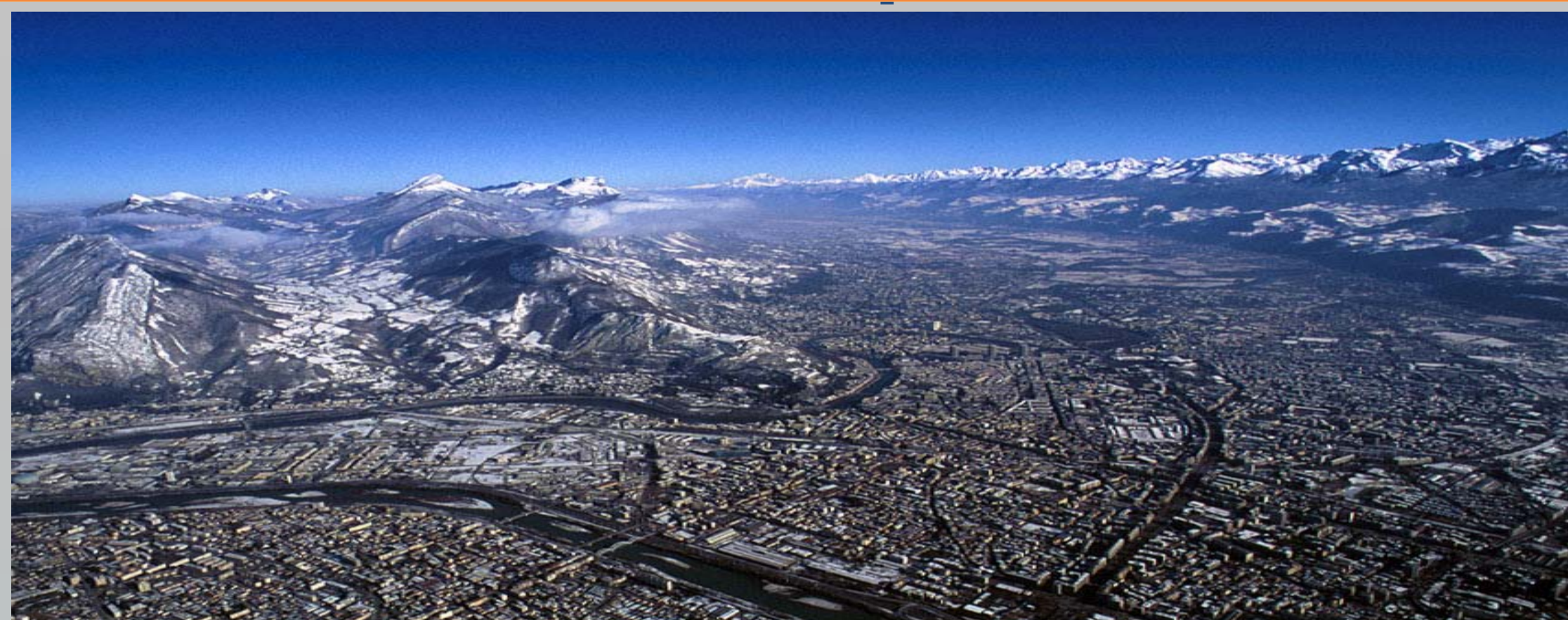
Mobile consultation

- Daily visit in surgery, orthopedic surgery, hematology, emergency ward
- Hotline (mobile phone) 24/7: answers to family physicians as well as non-university hospitals and clinics
- Daily emergency consultation
- Monthly multidisciplinary meeting for complicated bone and joint infections (orthopedics, rheumatologists, rehabilitators, microbiologists, infectious diseases physicians, imaging specialists)

Research topics

- **Clinical research:**
 - Encephalitis
 - Antibiotic stewardship
 - Vaccine
 - HIV
- **Basic research:**
 - Viral immunity

HIV infected patients

- Dedicated organization
- Medical and social staff
- Ambulatory medicine

Ambulatory medicine

- 4 dedicated beds
- Specific nurses
- Daycare for complicated patients

International vaccination and tropical medicine center

- Vaccinations for travelers
 - Yellow fever, TBE, JE, meningococci..
 - "metropolitan" vaccinations
- Specific counselling for travels
- Specific consultations for returning travellers
- Vaccinations for immunosuppressed patients (transplants, hematology...)

Teaching / typical week

- Weekly Bibliography
- Weekly Case presentations
- Daily meeting with microbiologists
- Daily briefing about the calls received on the hotline
- Monthly Infected bone meeting

Proposed fields as a collaborative center

- Antibiotic stewardship and mobile consultation
- Bone and joint infections
- Courses accepted from 1 week to 6 months
